



FELLOWS PROGRAM

The Ghetto Film School's Fellows Program is a visual storytelling course for high school students. Fellows receive more than 1,000 hours of immersive, college-level training, learning both the art and business of cinematic storytelling. In addition to engaging in production training, students also receive guidance to advance their education at top universities.

THE PROGRAM IS FREE OF CHARGE FOR ALL STUDENTS.

THE PROGRAM

In this 30-month filmmaking immersion, students will have the opportunity to receive instruction from **leading filmmakers** and **industry experts**, visit **live sets** and **studios**, get their films **screened at prestigious theaters**, and **travel internationally** to produce an original **thesis film**. We support our Fellows with **college application advising** and **test prep support**, and help them navigate their way into the industry through **paid internships at top media and creative companies**. Transportation and meals are covered throughout the program.

THE STUDENTS

We are seeking students **ages 14–18** who are passionate about film, television, and media. **No prior filmmaking experience is needed**, but the program requires an **exceptionally high level of commitment** from all participants. In addition to the 30-month class schedule, students and instructors oftentimes spend weekends and evenings at Ghetto Film School when additional time is necessary. **Perfect attendance is mandatory**. The value of your experience depends on maintaining great dedication to our program and your fellow filmmakers.
